

MAGNA PEGS™ ACTIVITY: “HAND HOLD ELIMINATION”

STUDENTS ARE CHALLENGED TO CLIMB USING FEWER AND FEWER HOLDS.



MATERIALS NEEDED:
Set of 30 Magna Pegs™



THE ACTIVITY:

Line students up along one side of climbing wall. Hand each student a Magna Peg™. As students climb, they place a Magna Peg™ in a hand hold. This makes that hold “off limits.” Students may NOT use any marked hold for their hands or feet. This is a great way to have students “problem solve” as they climb, instead of using the “easy” holds. Be sure to give all students a chance to traverse the wall at least twice since this activity becomes much more challenging for the last climbers.



AFTER THE ACTIVITY:

Process the activity using the following questions:

- What made you choose the hold you did to eliminate?
- What made this activity more challenging?
- What did you learn about yourself from this activity?
